GENERAL PARKING AT THE COASTAL DISCOVERY MUSEUM AT HONEY HORN

70 Honey Horn Drive, Hilton Head Island, SC 29926

All general spectators will enjoy complimentary parking at the Coastal Discovery Museum at Honey Horn, which is on the north end of Hilton Head Island. Motor coach service to and from Harbour Town (approximately a 20 minute ride) will be offered continuously during event hours. The motor coaches will begin each day at 6:30 am and stop at 9:30 pm. The motor coaches will pick up and drop off at the Harbour Town Marina. There is no general spectator parking inside The Sea Pines Resort.

TOURNAMENT SHUTTLE FROM COLIGNY PLAZA AREA

Complimentary shuttles will take spectators from the Coligny Beach parking lot to the drop off at the corner of Plantation Dr. and Lighthouse Rd. Parking in the Coligny Plaza area is first come, first served. Bicycle parking is also available. The shuttles will run from 6:30 am to 9:30 pm.

BICYCLE PARKING AT HARBOUR TOWN GOLF LINKS

Complimentary bicycle parking is available inside Sea Pines at the tennis courts next to the Harbour Town pool parking lot and at a second location near the 13th green at 16 Baynard Park Road. Owners are responsible for locking their own bicycle. All cyclists must have a tournament ticket or a volunteer badge to be admitted through the gates of Sea Pines. Cyclists may enter Sea Pines at the Ocean Gate or at the Main Gate.

HANDICAPPED PARKING INSIDE THE SEA PINES RESORT

Handicapped parking passes are issued by Sea Pines Security, located at 175 Greenwood Dr. in the CSA/Security Administration Building. Passes are issued at the Security Office only and cannot be distributed by mail. Call (843) 671-1343 for more information.

TOURNAMENT ISSUED PARKING PASSES

Vehicles with tournament issued parking passes, Sea Pines residents and Sea Pines vacation renters may park inside Sea Pines. Sea Pines Property Owners need to contact Sea Pines CSA offices at (843) 671-1343 for additional information.

UBER AND TAXIS

During tournament hours, the taxi cab and UBER designated pick up and drop off location is The Shops at Sea Pines Center. After hours, taxi cabs and UBER will be able to pick up at locations around the Harbour Town Golf Links once tournament play has ended.

GENERAL

SPECIAL NOTICE: Since the safety and well-being of everyone is of the utmost importance, please adhere to the standard tournament policies. All individuals will be subject to security screening, including metal detector screening and inspection of bags. Tickets and badges must be worn on the lanyards provided.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- No bags larger than a small purse 6" x 6" including carrying cases, backpacks, camera bags or chair bags
- No clear plastic, vinyl or other carry items larger than 12"x 6"x12"
- No plastic, metal, or glass cups, cans or containers of any kind except for medical or infant needs
- No computers or laptops
- No fireworks or laser pointers
- No lawn or oversize chairs or seat cushions
- No pets, except for service animals
- No knives, firearms or weapons of any nature
- No video cameras (all week)
- No cameras (during competition rounds)
- No selfie sticks
- No beverages (patrons may not bring in or exit with beverages) or coolers
- No radios or TVs
- No posters, signs or banners
- No hoverboards, skateboards or bicycles

All items are subject to search. You will be asked to return all unauthorized items to your car before you are allowed to board shuttles. Portable chairs must be removed from the course each night.

PERMITTED ITEMS

- Clear plastic, vinyl or other carry items not exceeding 12"x 6"x12"
- A one gallon clear re-sealable plastic bag
- At the tournament's discretion, food may enter the tournament in a clear plastic bag not to exceed the size of a one (1) gallon clear resealable plastic bag
- Mobile phones, tablets, and PDA's – MUST be on silent mode and adhere to the PGA TOUR's Mobile Device Policy
- Still cameras with lens smaller than 6 inches; no case (during practice rounds only)
- Umbrellas without sleeves
- Portable radios with headsets
- Medically necessary supplies, strollers, small diaper bags, plastic baby bottles, and other necessary baby supplies (infant must be with carrier) – items subject to search
- Collapsible chairs without chair bags
- Binoculars without case
- Seat cushions that do not require a carrying case or that do not have pockets or compartments

TOURNAMENT

BLEACHERS: There are bleachers located throughout the course. Access is on a first-come, first-served basis and is free for all spectators. Wheelchair accessible viewing areas are located at the 9th, 13th, 15th, 17th and 18th greens.

CONCESSION STANDS: Concession stands are located in the following areas and are all staffed by volunteers from local civic or non-profit organizations:

- 7th tee
- 8th green
- 10th fairway
- 13th green
- 15th green
- 18th fairway
- Heritage Lawn/17th green
- Wine at Nine

Clubhouse badge holders may purchase food and beverages inside the **CLUBHOUSE**, the **HERITAGE PAVILION**, the **OASIS** at 7th green or at **CLUBHOUSE II** at the 15th green.

THE ULTRA CLUB sells food and beverages behind the 18th green. Open to spectators who are of legal drinking age.

HERITAGE LAWN: This popular and fun spectator area starts just past the 16th green and ends along the 18th fairway. It is a great location to meet up with friends to watch the Golf Channel and CBS Sports' broadcasts on a large video board. A variety of activities are offered on the Heritage Lawn. Spectators can watch a family friendly movie on Tuesday night, spend time in the new Youth Zone and participate in Saturday's Plaid Nation Day contests.

TITO'S STILLHOUSE on the Heritage Lawn offers cocktails for spectators who are of legal drinking age.

WINE AT NINE is an open air wine bar located between holes 1 and 9. It will feature a large video board and golf viewing areas. It is open to all spectators who are of legal drinking age.

LIBERTY OAK EXPO area is located in the Marina next to the Harbour Town Lighthouse. Spectators are invited to visit the display tents to view and interact with the many products being promoted.

RBC HERITAGE MERCHANDISE PAVILION is located between the 1st and 9th holes. Additional pop-up tents can be found on the Heritage Lawn and at Liberty Oak.

FIRST AID STATION: A First Aid Station can be found next to the tournament's main entrance by the Harbour Town Clubhouse. If the need for medical assistance should occur, please notify the nearest RBC Heritage Volunteer.

INFORMATION

AUTOGRAPH POLICY: An autograph policy is only in effect for official competition rounds (Thursday - Sunday). Once a player's round has started, he may not sign autographs until the round is completed, except at his option during a period of suspension of play. Autographed items are limited to a size of 8.5 x 11". Clipboards will NOT be allowed.

LOST AND FOUND: Lost and Found is inside the Will Call/Ticket Trailer located in the Clubhouse parking lot.

WILL CALL: Will Call is in the Ticket Trailer located in the parking lot of Harbour Town Golf Links. Will Call is designed for last minute ticket sales, ticket pick-up and redistribution of tournament badges. A picture ID is required to pick-up your tickets.

MOBILE DEVICE POLICY:

- Devices must be on silent at all times; flash may not be used.
- Devices may be used to capture video, audio and photos (content) in all areas throughout tournament week.
- Content may be used for personal purposes (e.g., personal social media); no commercial use.
- No live streaming or real-time coverage (e.g., no shot-by-shot coverage).
- Data use (e.g., texting) is permitted in all areas throughout tournament week.
- Phone calls are allowed only in designated areas.

 - * Concessions located at holes 9, 10, 13, 15, 18
 - * Neighborhood roads
- Please be respectful of play and do not interfere with players, caddies or media.
- All posted signage and instructions from tournament staff must be observed.
- Failure to comply with this policy may result in the revocation of your ticket.
